AAS Bilateral Agreement Inventory

Transfer agreements for associate in applied science programs (AAS), which are not designed for transfer, require bilateral rather than statewide articulation. Under bilateral agreements, Durham Technical Community College enters into a partnership with a university or college to facilitate the transfer of students from specific AAS degree programs to baccalaureate degree programs. The accompanying bilateral inventory lists those collaborations between Durham Technical Community College and four-year institutions.
