


Congratulations to our Fall 2020 Honors Program Students!

novel *The Awakening*.




Gayle Krest

Her Honors project for HIS 132 with Professor DePalma will uncover the successes and failures of American diplomacy during the Iran Hostage Crisis.


This is her **third** Honors Project.
